11. For there is born to you this day in the city of David, a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
12. And this will be the sign to you: you will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths lying in a manger
13. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying:
14. "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men!"

JANUARY

Ephesians 6:1-4

1. Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this right.
2. Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise:
3. That it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.
4. And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

FEBRUARY

Psalms 1:1

1. Blessed is the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful.
2. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in his law he meditates day and night.
3. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither, and whatever he does shall prosper.
4. The ungodly are not so, but are like the chaff which the wind drives away.
5. Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

Steps of salvation and a scripture for each:

HEAR (Romans 10:17) So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

BELIEF (Mark 16:16) He who believes and is baptized will be saved, he who does not believe will be condemned.

FAITH (Hebrews 11:6) But without faith it is impossible to please Him; for he who cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

A DOER (James 1:22) But be doers of the word and not hearers only.
