Expectations:

Consistent Attendance: A leader can't be effective if they are not present.

Visible Leadership: Although being an outspoken and up in front of everyone leader is not required, you are still expected to be a visible leader. This includes: setting an example by respecting the adult leadership, engaging in the lessons and encouraging others to do the same, focusing on God during times of worship, welcoming newcomers and taking an interest in others.

Personal Devotion: Christians are given direct access to God. A student leader is expected to have a growing personal relationship with God through regular quiet time. This consists of a time specifically set aside to read and reflect on scripture and pray.
